Dear Grandmasters, Masters and Instructors,

The ITF Taekwon-Do Union Canada Association is very excited to host Grandmaster Don Dalton (9th Dan) and President of ITF Union for an amazing weekend of training including a Grandmaster Class and International Instructor's Course (IIC) on June 6th and 7th, 2026, in St. John's, Newfoundland and Labrador, CANADA. It is with great pleasure that we invite you and your students to this event and incredible opportunity. This event is open to all affiliations of ITF.

This event will be held at the College of the North Atlantic in their full gymnasium. On Saturday morning, a Grandmaster Class will be conducted by GM Dalton for Green Belt to 9th Dan black belt, ages 7 and over. Following the Grandmaster Class, an International Instructor's Course (IIC) will be held in the afternoon for red belt to 9th Dan black belt. The IIC portion of the event for Red Belt to 9th Dan Black Belt will continue Sunday for the full day. The IIC will cover all technical aspects of Taekwon-Do as created by General Choi Hong Hi and will also cover how to teach these aspects to students.

WHAT TO BRING:

- Water Bottle
- Snack / lunch if you are Red Belt and above.
- Notebook and Pen
- Sparring Gear

PARTICIPATION RULES:

- Participants must wear a White Dobok which must be clean and ironed
- Before each session participants must line up to welcome the Grand Masters and Masters
- After each session participants remain in place until the Grand Masters and Masters leave the training hall
- Participants must act according to the tenets of Taekwon-Do
- Participants standing at ease must assume ready stance with their hands behind their back always
- Participants sitting at ease must cross their legs and never show the soles of their feet to the Grand Masters and Masters
- Participants are permitted to ask questions but, in all cases, they should stand up, bow and assume a ready stance with their hands behind their back when asking questions
- No spectators are permitted in the training hall during the Grandmaster Class or IIC
- Filming and photography are only permitted with the prior approval of the President / IIC Instructor
- The IIC certificate will only be issued to those who have completed the full course
